Mahashivaratri: Amarnath, the rare Shiva Linga formed of ice.










Amarnath temple is located in Kashmir, 145 km east of Srinagar. Legend has it that this is the very cave where Lord Shiva unravelled the secret of life and eternity to his divine consort, Parvati.

Mystical ice lingam is considered as among the holiest shrines .

This natural stalagmite formation takes shape due to the freezing of water drops that trickle down from the roof of the cave on to the floor beneath. It then rises vertically from the floor and waxes and wanes with the moon. Alongside the Shiva Lingam are also two ice lingams regarded as of Parvati and Ganesha.

Amarnath cave can be accessed during the 45 day window during July to August . The Amarnath Yatra trek begins on the panchami day of the bright half of the moon at Srinagar.











Intresting Facts: Dara Singh





May 29, 1968 was a historic day for India in wrestling as Dara Singh was crowned World Champion.

In Mumbai (then Bombay) he defeated Lou Thesz of USA to win the title.

Dara eventually retired from the sport in 1983 after having been in over 500 fights. Surprisingly, he never lost a match during his career.

His contribution to wrestling has been seen as a benchmark for generations to follow.

Other than the sport, Dara had also acted in several films between 1952 to 2012.


He died on July 12, 2012 and is fondly remembered as one of the pioneers who put Indian wrestling on the map. He has left behind a legacy and even now, 50 years after he became World Champion, people still remember him fondly.
