What is Geographical Indication (GI)?


The word GI is an indication of the geographical location which indicates the product associated with a certain area or region. Actually, it has become a trademark of that region and the place becomes famous by the name of that product. It is used for agricultural, natural and manufactured goods having a special quality and established a reputation. They not only provide a way for business to leverage the value of their geographically unique products, but also inform and attract consumers.

Darjeeling tea became the first GI tagged product in India, in 2004-05, since then by May 2017, 295 products had been added to the list. The Geographical Indication is the sign used on the products that have the regional origin and which can be depicted from its label

Karnataka tops with 38 GI products, followed by Maharashtra which has 32 GI products. Tamil Nadu comes third with 25 GI products.

### **Aunts**




