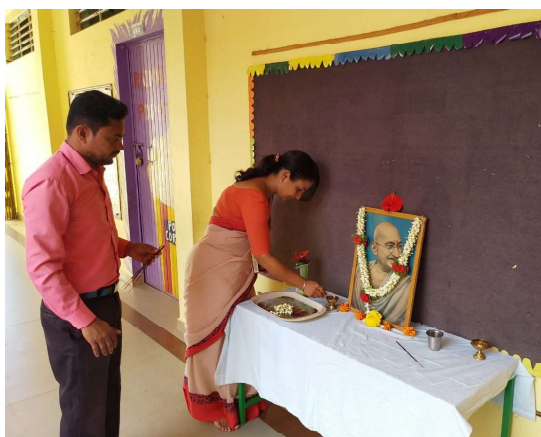
They are able to access the content better when they can learn holistically. When they return to school, the trip that they took can serve as a touchpoint for an entire unit.

Field Trips for all the classes

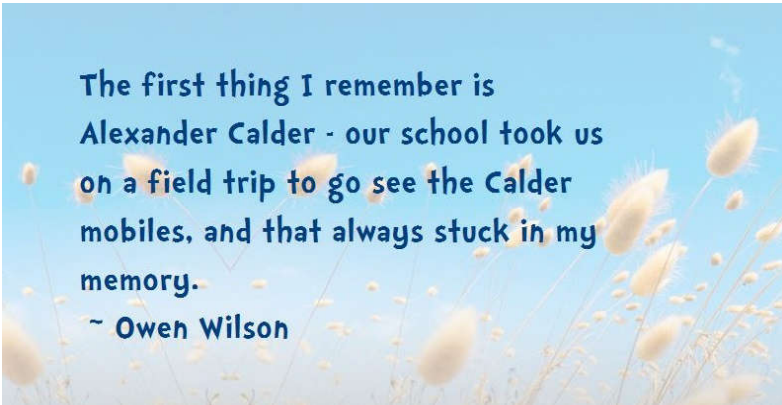
RPS had scheduled school trips to all the classes. The classes were grouped based on the age range of the children, and suitable places of interest were chosen.

Chairman's Address to Teachers



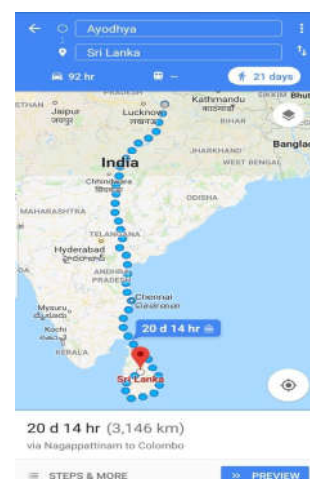
"Motivation is the desire to act and move towards a goal "

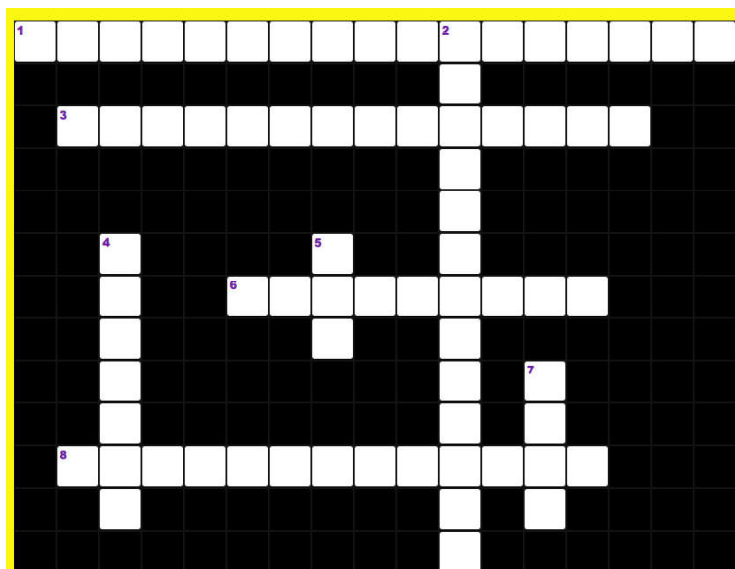
Interesting Trivia : 20 days between Dasara and Deepavali
